David Yepsen

David Yepsen is the chief political correspondent for The Des Moines Register. A native Iowan, he has covered government and politics for The Des Moines Register for 32 years.

Yepsen was born in 1951 in Jefferson, Iowa. In 1972, he graduated from the University of Iowa with a Bachelor of General Studies.

Yepsen began his full-time newspaper career at the Quad-City Times in Davenport in 1972. He was there for two years before he joined The Des Moines Tribune in 1974, and soon thereafter, moved over to The Des Moines Register.

In 1977, Yepsen started covering the legislature. He became political editor in 1994 and in 2000, a full-time political columnist. During his time at The Register, he also earned a Master's degree in public administration at Drake University in 1985.

In 1989, Yepsen was a fall fellow at the Joan Shorenstein Center on the Press, Politics and Public Policy at Harvard University. He has been a panelist on Iowa Public Television's *Iowa Press* program since the late 1970s and has appeared on PBS' The NewsHour with Jim Lehrer, CNN, Fox, MSNBC and CSPAN.
